Understanding the Skilled Worker Route

The Skilled Worker visa allows non-UK nationals to live and work in the UK for an approved employer. This route replaced earlier work visa categories and focuses on skills, salary levels, and employer sponsorship rather than nationality alone.

It also offers long-term benefits, including visa extensions and a future settlement pathway, provided all conditions continue to be met.

Who Can Apply for Skilled Worker Visa UK

Eligibility depends on both the applicant and the employer meeting specific criteria.

Job Offer from a Licensed Sponsor

Applicants must have a genuine job offer from a UK employer that holds a valid sponsor licence. The employer plays a central role by issuing a Certificate of Sponsorship.

Role and Salary Eligibility

The job must be on the list of eligible occupations and meet the required skill level. The salary offered must meet the minimum threshold set for the role, including any occupation-specific rate.

Meeting these standards is essential when you **apply for skilled worker visa uk**.

Documents Required for the Application

This electronic certificate contains details of the role, salary, employer, and employment duration. All information must match the visa application exactly.

English Language Evidence
